



WHAT TO KNOW & HOW TO PREPARE

- No construction experience necessary! Our House Leaders will ensure a variety of tasks are available for all individuals with a wide variety of skill levels and physical abilities.
- Wear comfortable clothes that can get dirty and dress for the weather. We do not guarantee heat/air condition at any of our work sites
- Wear closed-toed shoes or work boots (no open-toed shoes)
- Remove jewelry and pull back loose hair
- There are disposable water bottles on site or bring your own bottle to save on plastic waste. Some congregations provide lunches for their crew. Look for lunch information in your reminder email. We break for lunch hour at noon.
 - Port-a-jons will be available
 - Tools & equipment are provided. You are welcome to bring your own, but you are responsible for them, and they are subject to our House Leader's safety check
- **Safety is our highest priority! Keeping a safe worksite is everyone's responsibility.** All PPE will be provided, but you can bring your own (eye protection, work gloves, mask, etc)
- **Projects:** Expected tasks will be emailed to you the week of your build day. Please dress accordingly
- **Age Restrictions:** Due to safety regulations, teens under the age of 16 are not permitted on our active sites. Ages 16 - 17 must have a waiver completed by a parent/guardian and be accompanied by an adult while on site
