WHAT TO KNOW & HOW TO PREPARE

- **No construction experience necessary!**
Our House Leaders will ensure a variety of tasks are available for a wide variety of skill levels and physical abilities.
- Wear comfortable clothes that can get dirty and dress for the weather. **We do not guarantee heat/air condition at any of our work sites**
- Wear closed-toed shoes or work boots (no open-toed shoes)
- Remove jewelry and pull back loose hair
- We have disposable water bottles on site or bring your own bottle to save on plastic waste. Some congregations prepare lunch for the crew. Look for lunch information in the reminder email
- Port-a-jons will be available
- Tools & equipment will be provided. You are welcome to bring your own, but you are responsible for them, and they are subject to our House Leader's safety check
- **Safety is our highest priority!**
Keeping a safe worksite is everyone's responsibility. All PPE will be provided, but you can bring your own (eye protection, work gloves, mask, etc)
- **Projects:** Expected tasks will be emailed to you the week of your build day. Please dress accordingly
- **Age Restrictions:** Due to safety regulations, individuals under the age of 16 are not permitted on our active sites. Those ages 16 - 17 must have a waiver completed by a parent/guardian and be accompanied by an adult while on site

Volunteers must register online or with their congregation's liaison by the Monday before each scheduled build day. **Location changes, expected tasks, and additional details will be emailed the week of each scheduled build day.**

All **MUST** arrive by 9 AM and plan to stay on site until the projects have been completed.

Your volunteer support is critical for our team to maintain projected completion timelines and to keep costs down. If you have registered for this event and are no longer able to attend, please reach out to us or update your registration as soon as possible.
